

<u>DIRECTOR OF TRAINING</u>: Began work Tuesday, 03 September. This week is orientation, picked up local PPE, computer ordered, review of NFPA standards and the WAC. Introduced Captain Babcock at Tuesday evening drill. Captain Babcock will plan and coordinate drill on Tuesday, 10 September. Once his desk arrives, he'll need a day or two of office 'nesting.'

<u>SCHOOL EVACUATION DRILLS</u>: Captain Schrank met with each school and scheduled monthly fire evacuation drills and lockdown drills. Monthly drill are mandated by the State.
