COMMISSIONER'S REPORT

Chairman Riel reminded everyone that the WFCA Spring Series Conference is this Saturday March 2nd, 2024 in Spokane, WA. Chairman Riel, Commissioner Brandt, DC Lamoureux, DS Roberts and AA Frost will be attending. FC Hille and Commissioner St, Mary will attend the same conference at a later date in Tulalip, WA. Commissioner Brandt also informed everyone that the communications committee is looking for an assistant to help them part-time. Commissioner Brandt said he would gather more information and stay in touch.

GENERAL DISCUSSION

- FC Hille informed the board that he applied the department for the Yakima Cares Grant through Yakima Legends Casino. The grant is \$16,000 and would go toward a quantitative filter to test SCBA masks and for the maintenance.
- DC Lamoureux informed the board that he also has applied for the Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) to go toward getting an extractor for Station 42 and training to get all career personnel to Fire Officer 2.
- The SAFER Grant will open in March and FC Hille plans on applying for it again in hopes of hiring 3 more career firefighters in 2024.
- The department has purchased an ice machine and ice box for Station 42 from Coca Cola in Yakima. It is installed and running.
- FC Hille also sat in on a meeting with Patty Murray's assistant regarding why departments like ours with full-time career staff aren't receiving the grants they are applying for and why they're being awarded to smaller departments with no full-time staff.
