Chief Hille stated the committees will not need to get back together but he will do some follow-up with the committee members for clarification on any issues that arise.

**b.** Discuss Lexipol and editing Policies, Rules, SOG's. 2 policies have been issued to date #1208 Respiratory Protection Program & #1645 Work Hours & Compensation.

Lexipol costs: 2018 \$4,138 2019 \$5,743 2020 \$5,982 Total \$15,863

AD Huitt mentioned that Chief Hille had brought with him Grant 3's policies, only 2 policies have been issued through Lexipol in the last 3 years, and the need for all of the District's policies to be updated. The Board requested a copy of Grant 3's policies be forwarded so they can see the formatting, and that Lexipol had been challenging to use. Chief Hille suggested not renewing Lexipol, and saving the money since it was not being utilized and the Board agreed.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

#### a. Training Captain use of Expedition

Chief Hille would like to see Captain Babcock take home the Expedition so he can respond directly to the scene if the district has any major events. Chief Emery had offered this to Captain Babcock during the hiring process. The Board was in agreement, but asked that the vehicle be checked for safety before this is implemented.
