COMMISSIONER'S REPORT

Commissioner Riel reported that there was a WFCA state board meeting via conference call. The Chelan conference for June of 2020 has been cancelled and all reservations will be moved to 2021. At this time the WFCA Fall Conference in Spokane is still expected to happen and Commissioner Riel would like everyone to fill out the upcoming survey suggesting possible improvements, topics or classes, and entertainment. Chairman Ramynke would like the proposed legal topic for the cancelled June seminar to be addressed at the Fall conference if possible.

GENERAL DISCUSSION – Limited between Board and Staff – NO PUBLIC INPUT

<u>COVID19</u>: Chairman Ramynke asked about member morale due to the current pandemic, and stated he and others were feeling disconnected. Captain Evers stated that some of the Part-Time-Paid Volunteers are feeling stressed and disconnected lately as well. Chief Emery said he was just following the advice of the CDC and governor as to when the Academy and PTP members could resume regular activity, and a big concern is that anyone can be asymptomatic and still spread the virus. Chief Emery also raised concern that when the governor releases younger adults to be more social, people over 60 will still need to isolate as much as possible. Commissioner Riel noted that there are many more positive cases with the younger adults.

<u>Station 42 Remodel</u>: Chief Emery asked for an update on where we are with the Station 42 permit for the fire sprinkler line and Commissioner Riel asked the Chief to follow up with Inland Fire and find out what still needs to be done.

<u>Prothman Hiring Search</u>: Chairman Ramynke asked AD Huitt to get an update on the Fire Chief search through Prothman.

<u>EVFD Recruit Fire Academy</u>: Captain Babcock stated the Academy is in a holding pattern for now due to the pandemic. He would like the Academy to finish before fire season begins, but we will have to see how it goes for now.

<u>Training Center Offer during 2020 Fire Season</u>: Captain Evers let everyone know that BC Goldsmith with the Training Center expressed a willingness to send their Training Center-based aircraft out immediately to any fires on the north side of Hwy 24 and, if there is justification for the south side of Hwy 24, like a strong southerly wind, it could be dispatched to assist there as well.
